From the Chief of Police

Honorable Mayor & Nekoosa Common Council,

It is with great pride that I submit my 19th Police Department Annual Report. It is a privilege to work with elected officials and police officers who are so dedicated to the welfare and safety of our community. With the training and equipment you provide, our hard working officers are able to perform at a high level of efficiency and professionalism.

In January, we upgraded our computer network server to accommodate the large video files being created by our squad car dash cameras. The cameras have been a nice addition to our squads and have proved invaluable in the prosecution of many traffic cases.

In April, we increased the hours of the School Resource Officer at the request of the Nekoosa School District. We also purchased and replenished our supply of practice ammunition for firearms training. Assistant Chief Shawn Woods is not only our school resource officer but he is also our Firearms Instructor. Assistant Chief Woods continues to do an excellent job at all the positions he holds.

In June, we promoted part time police officer Brian Machon to full time. Officer Machon was promoted to replace Officer Charles Hoogesteger who accepted a position as a Wood County Deputy Sheriff. We were fortunate to find such a good quality officer to replace Officer Hoogesteger. Officer Hoogesteger did a great job for the community and I'm pleased he will still be serving the residents of Wood County. Officer Machon continues to perform admirably.

Senior Patrolman Jason Dhein assists me with assuring that all preliminary breath testers are frequently calibrated. In the event we need to deflate tires, he assures that all our Stinger road spikes are ready for deployment. Officer Dhein also assists with the field training of new officers and his experience and expertise have been invaluable.

In November, we purchased new Tasers. The Taser is a very effective electronic compliance tool. With Officer Josh Kolo's instructions we are recertified every year in the use of this device. Officer Kolo is also our Defensive Tactics Instructor and Time System Access Coordinator. He trains and assists all Officers in their bi-annual recertification to use our Mobile Data Computers and defensive tactics. Officer Kolo is a great asset to our department.

In December, we upgraded our Mobile Data Computers. Officer Brandon Christianson celebrated his third year of employment with our department. Officer Christianson is a hard working employee with a great attitude. We are grateful to have him on staff in Nekoosa.

In closing I would like to take this opportunity to thank you again for all your support and cooperation. On behalf of all the Officers in the Nekoosa Police Department, I would like to tell you what a distinct honor it is to protect and serve the citizens of this great community. They are in fact some of the nicest people in the world.

School Resource Officer

Service to the School District continues to be a very rewarding experience. It is gratifying to be able to assist staff and students in their time of need and celebrate with them during their victories.

There are countless success stories that emerge from Nekoosa High School which are often overshadowed by despair and tragedy. Both are ever present in the public school system. Most of my time is spent at the high school assisting Principal Mike Kumm with various discipline issues as well as maintaining a secure building. Safety of students, staff, and property is the main focus of the Nekoosa School Resource Officer Program.

In addition to discipline and safety, I teach classes relating to alcohol and it's effects on the body for Mrs. Walker's senior science class.

My time at Alexander Middle School is spent teaching internet safety and harmful effects of alcohol. AMS is a lively place with great kids. Middle school kids are experiencing many of the same temptations as their older counterparts at NHS. The harmful effects of drugs, alcohol, and sex are sometimes seen at AMS. As School Resource Officer, I assist Principal Jon Sprehn and Guidance Counselor Rod Winters in dealing with these serious issues.

Humke Elementary School is a great place to be for a School Resource Officer. The kids are very warm and welcoming. Most of my interaction with elementary kids is in the cafeteria or during classes. I teach classes on multiple safety issues including crosswalk, bicycle, and gun safety.

Finally, I occasionally get calls from the staff of Nekoosa Academy. The atmosphere at the Academy is much more relaxed producing a different kind of learning environment. Kids at the Academy have many of the same needs and successes as kids at the high school.

It is a pleasure to serve in the capacity as Nekoosa Schools Resource Officer. The Administrative team and staff in the district are great to work with.

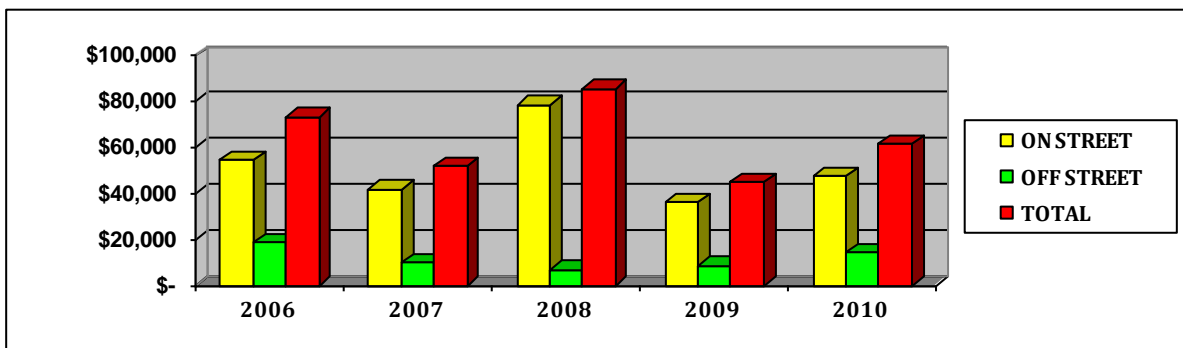
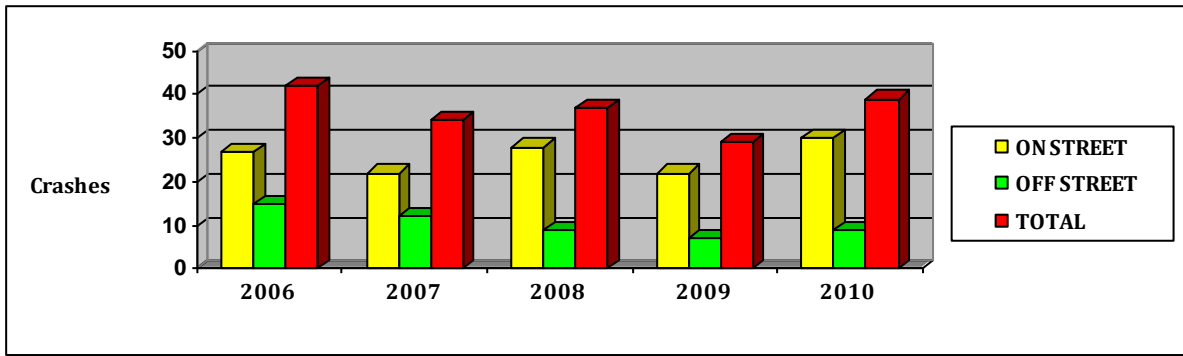
